1. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that for the purposes of this Order, the definitions set out in the Settlement Agreement between the Plaintiff and the Defendants dated June 3, 2021 apply to and are incorporated into this Order.

2. THIS COURT ORDERS that, in accordance with section 32(2) of the Class

Proceedings Act, 1992, S.O. 1992, c. 6 (the "CPA"), Class Counsel fees are approved and fixed

in the amount of \$6,675,000, being 30% of the Settlement Amount as agreed in the Amended

Contingency Fee Retainer Agreement, plus 13% HST, and that the legal fees shall be paid to

Class Counsel from the Trust Account on the Effective Date.

3. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that, in accordance with section 32(2) of the CPA,

disbursements incurred by Class Counsel of \$218,668.67, inclusive of taxes and charges, are

approved and shall be paid to Class Counsel from the Trust Account forthwith on the Effective

Date.

4. THIS COURT ORDERS that, Augusta Pool 1 Canada Limited shall be paid \$3,945,000

from the Settlement Amount.

5. THIS COURT ORDERS that \$780,000 shall be set aside from the Settlement Amount

for the purpose of Administration Expenses.

6. THIS COURT ORDERS that the representative plaintiff, Marc-Oliver Baroch, be paid

an honorarium of \$10,000.

7. THIS COURT ORDERS that in the event of a conflict between this Order and the

Settlement Agreement, this Order shall prevail.
